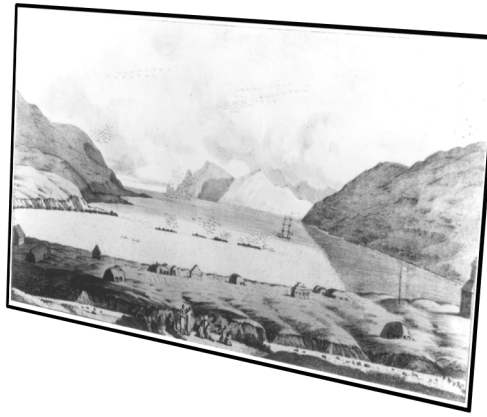


# Community Art Contest

## GUIDELINES

1. Open to Unalaska and surrounding communities
2. Entries should be original artwork (such as drawings, paintings, original prints, photographs, etc.) measuring 8-1/2" x 11," but no larger than 11" x 17."
3. Entries may be three dimensional sculpture documented by high-resolution photographs from at least five angles (right side, front, left side, back, and top). Width of sculpture not to exceed 2 1/2 inches
4. Artwork should not feature images of identifiable people unless accompanied by a signed and dated release from each such person that includes his or her name, contact information and a statement authorizing the use of his or her image.
5. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form and, if under 18, signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.
6. Entries not selected for prizes may be returned upon advance written request. APIA shall not be liable for damage to any entries.
7. Entries will be reviewed by a selection committee and judged on factors such as artistic quality and originality. At APIA's discretion, the winners' photographs, names, communities, cultural affiliations and reproductions of their artworks will be published in APIA's print and online materials, including the APIA newsletter.
8. If there are any ties, they will be decided by APIA's President/CEO.

**DEADLINE:** Original artworks and completed entry forms must be received by APIA on or before August 16, 2021.
